Swim Coordinator

A swim coordinator does a little bit of everything!! No day is ever the same Swim coordinators are not in the water with the dogs. Some of the duties you may be asked to perform as a swim coordinator include but are not limited to:

- Greet all clients and usher them to the appropriate areas
- Answering the phone
- Scheduling clients
- Completes customer's transactions
- Helping the swim instructor
- Helping clients with semi-assisted swims
- Bathing of client's dogs
- Laundry
- Stocking inventory
- General cleaning tasks
- Quick in-town errands (bank or post office)

We can be flexible around other jobs and schooling. Must be 16 years of age to apply. We are open 6 days a week and ask that you work a minimum of 12 hours per week, except for those persons still in high school.



Swim Instructor

A swim instructor is the rehab specialist in the pool with the dogs. A swim instructor must be certified in Pet First Aid & CPR and well as have their Hydrotherapy Certification. Both certifications can be obtained via on-the-job training if need be. We also ask that swim instructors have a baseline knowledge of dog body language and behavior.

Some of the duties you may be asked to perform as a swim instructor include but are not limited to:

- All duties of the swim coordinator
- Speaking to clients about products and services
- Performing any of our services on the dogs
- Basic pool maintenance with the guidance from one of our Certified Pool Operators

We can be flexible around other jobs and schooling. Must be 18 years of age to apply. We are open 6 days a week and ask that you work a minimum of 16 hours per week.
